**TO: All Member Societies of the International Society of Endocrinology**

Dear Colleagues,

In its strategic plan, ISE has defined a priority to focus on facilitating pathways for career development opportunities for the future generation and emerging leaders in global endocrinology.

Therefore, we are now seeking your Society's nomination to constitute a new committee of early career clinicians and researchers that ISE has set to establish according to its strategic plan: the Early Career Committee (ECC) of ISE.

We would like to involve our national members societies in this process and ask you to provide **a minimum of one and a maximum of three names of young endocrinology practitioners and-or researchers.**

To be eligible to join the ECC you should meet one of the following criteria:

- Early Career Researcher: a basic, translational or clinical researcher with a PhD or MD who has completed their training within the last 10 years. Membership shall be for a two-year term, renewable once. Members wishing to be re-elected, can make themselves available for re-election at the end of their initial term.
- Early Career Clinical Trainee: a certified board endocrinologist within the last 10 years.

Membership of the ECC is free, on a voluntary basis and shall consist of appointed representatives, scientists and clinicians from ISE member societies. They must have completed their training within the last 10 years.

Ideal ECC candidates would be expected to be someone who can bring distinctive international outlook and expertise to the committee, ideally


